For those of you who do not have access to a computer, paper copies will be available in your local church porch and village notice boards.

The findings will be considered by the Parish Council prior to submission to the County Council.

Funds are available for the renovation of stiles and gates so let's get walking and checking our parish footpaths and bridleways!
